hits the spot!

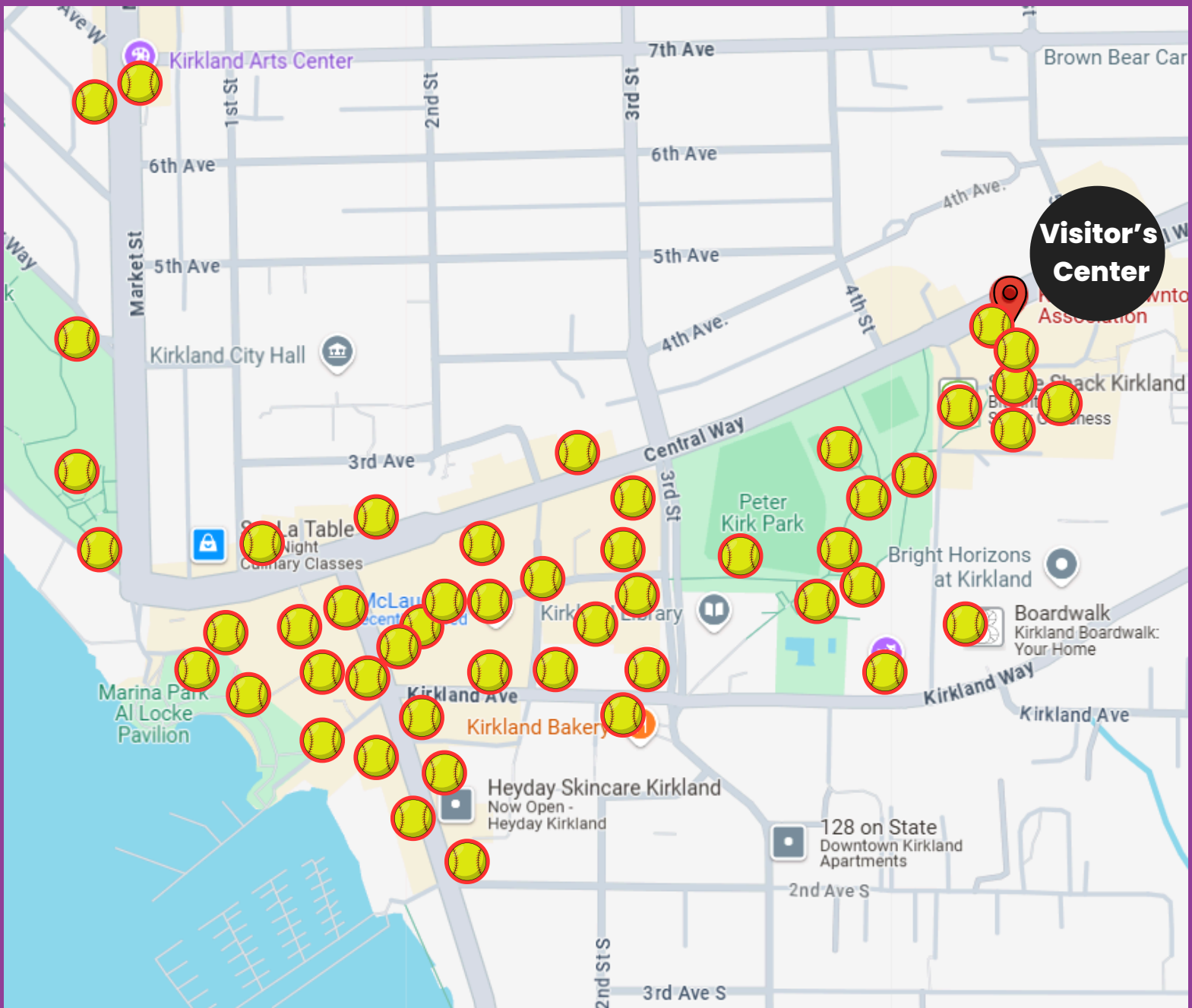
Where players run
